JLTV's library contains over 2,000 hours of Jewish-themed programming.

Airing with morning and evening editions on JLTV, i24news is an international 24-hour news and current affairs TV channel based in Jaffa Port, Tel Aviv, Israel with broadcasts in English, French and Arabic - broadcasting over satellites and cable operators in Europe, Africa, the Middle East and Asia and reaching a potential of 900 million homes in those regions.

Classic episodes of the Sesame Street adaptation, introducing children to Israel and Judaism. Many of Hollywood's top celebrities have participated in this outstanding series, which helps children better understand their Jewish roots and learn more about Israel through the Hebrew alphabet and other creative avenues.

Up and coming and established artists from Israel and the Jewish World. Produced by Zev Brenner, this program builds itself on a combination of religious and upbeat music.





More than two decades before *The Joan Rivers Show* of the early 1990s and when her daughter, Melissa, was barely a year old, Joan hosted her own syndicated daytime talk show in the late 1960s called *That Show with Joan Rivers*. The half-hour program features an expert guest tackling a particular subject-of-the-day, mixing it up with an unlikely celebrity guest. Joan delivers 300 words a minute, hilariously tearing into every subject. *That Show* is a virtual time capsule of subject matters and personalities of the day.



Hosts, Lee Lazerson and Rabbi Yaakov Thompson highlight Jewish life in the United States, Israel and around the world on their program originating from South Florida.



The weekend version of *Bodies In Motion*, this program provides an extended workout with Israeli exercise guru Gilad Janklowicz. The production is based in beautiful Hawaii and historic sites in Israel. This program is a hit with women.

The General Assembly (GA)

Held in the fall by the Jewish Federations of North America, representing over 300 Jewish communities on the continent. Thousands gather to discuss local, regional, national and international issues. JLTV broadcasts the major plenary sessions live.

Independence Day, July 4th

JLTV has produced historical perspectives of America and its Jewish population. Our viewers learn about such heroes as Haym Solomon, who helped to finance the American Revolution. He raised (in today's currency) several billions of dollars to clothe and feed the Revolutionary Army. Uriah P. Levy, the first Commodore of the U.S. Navy, was responsible for the abolishment of corporal punishment and walking the plank.

Israel Football Bowl

American football has arrived in Israel and now developed to a point where the league's two winning teams play off in the Israel Football Bowl. This past championship game saw the Tel Aviv team challenge the Judean Hills team. Another live broadcast from Israel!

Israel's Birthday (Yom HaAtzmaut)

Every year, JLTV produces an Israel birthday celebration to recognize the Jewish homeland's reason for being. Stories of the pioneers of Israel with archival footage, along with Israeli folk music from the past to Israeli rap music of the present. It's a moment to rejoice.

Maccabiah Games

Every four years, JLTV broadcasts live the Opening Ceremonies and various competitive events of the two-week sports adventure that has become the third largest sporting event in the world behind the Olympics and the World Cup. Nearly 10,000 athletes from nearly 70 countries participate in this astounding moment in time.

Nobel Prize Ceremonies

Never before has the Nobel Prize Ceremony been aired across America in its entirety. Every December 10th, JLTV broadcasts the Nobel Prize Ceremony live and direct from Stockholm, Sweden. Jews have been the recipients of twenty seven percent of the Nobel Prizes awarded.

Passover Seder

With our own celebrity hosts and personalities, JLTV broadcasts its Passover Seder every year, introducing new ideas to its Jewish viewers and the meaning of Passover and the Seder to our non-Jewish audience.

Remembering the Zionist Congress in Basel

JLTV will begin broadcasting an annual event from the very hall where over 200 delegates gathered first in 1897 in Basel, Switzerland, to call for the creation of a Jewish State in the land of Israel – led and organized by Theodore Herzl. A Hollywood celebrity and/or Jewish leader will deliver his actual words, in English, every year from this very important location in Jewish history.


Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur Holiday Services
